





<sup>1</sup>**Processor License:** Processing/Manufacturing license for an approved facility that produces foods for sale and distribution; annual license.

<sup>2</sup>**USDA:** United State Department of Agriculture; [usda.gov](http://usda.gov)

<sup>3</sup>**ODAFF:** Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, & Forestry; [oda.state.ok.us](http://oda.state.ok.us)

<sup>4</sup>**TCS Foods:** Foods that must be maintained at 41°F to prevent the growth of harmful bacteria

<sup>5</sup>**Mobile Retail License:** Can sell prepackaged processed foods statewide; may also require an approved licensed commissary where the food is stored; annual license.

<sup>6</sup>**Non-TCS Foods:** Foods that do not allow for the growth of harmful bacteria due to processing or natural factors.

<sup>7</sup>**Seasonal License:** Can sell non-TCS prepackaged foods at one location; valid for 180 consecutive days.

**Special Event Licenses** are not available for regularly scheduled, reoccurring events, such as Farmers' Markets.

**The aforementioned license exemptions are only applicable at Registered Farmers' Markets in Oklahoma.**
