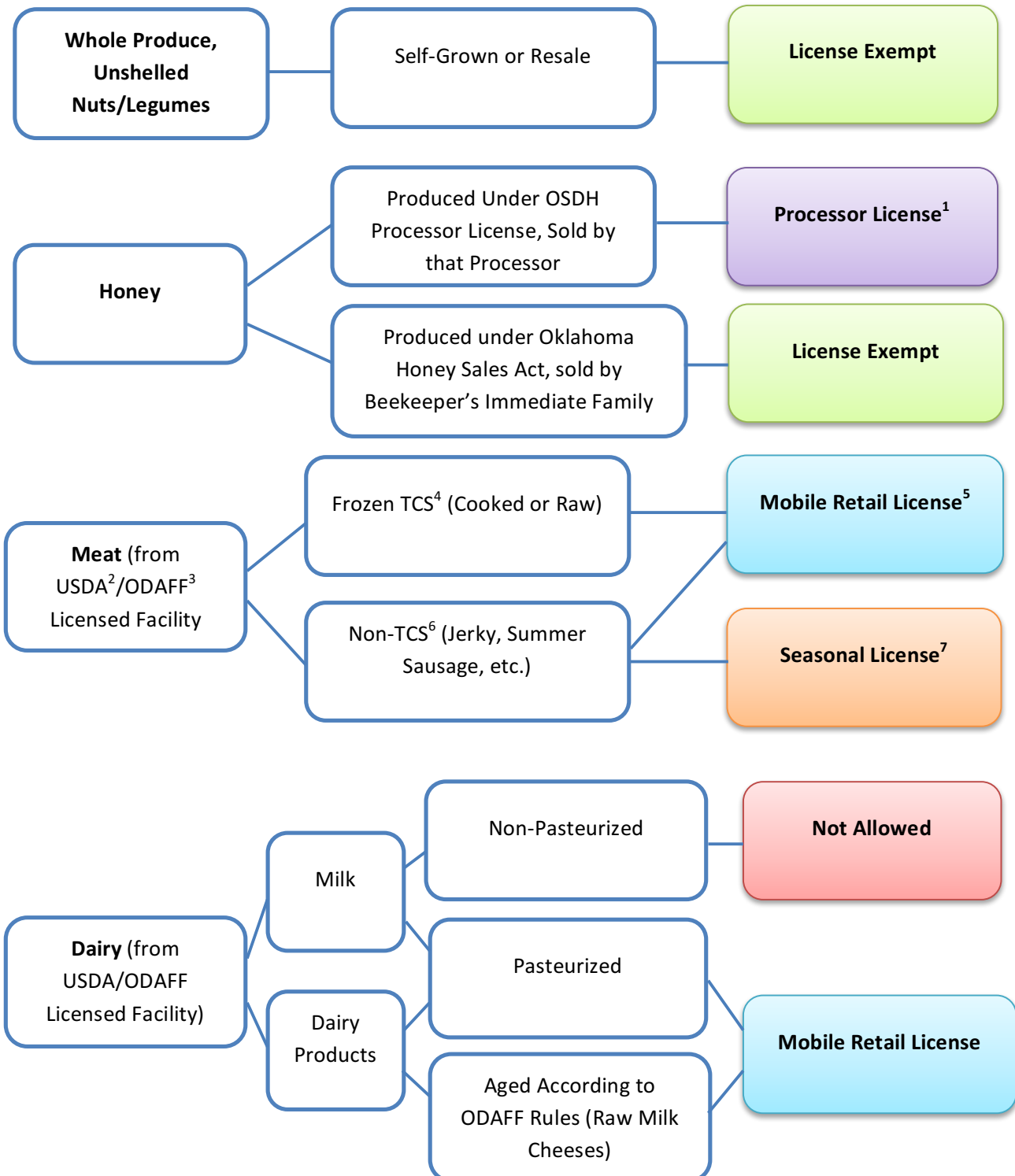
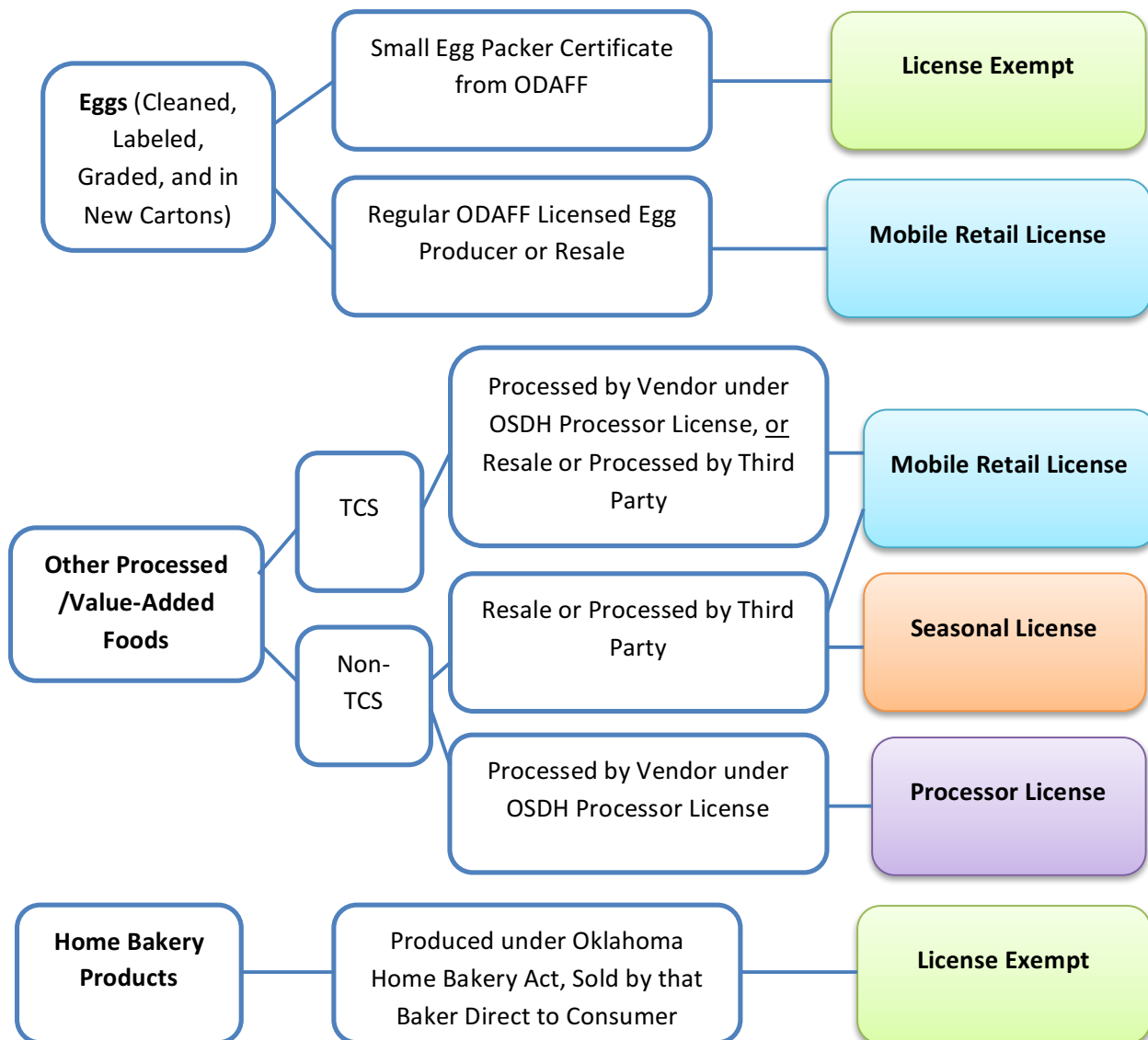




Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) Licenses Required by Vendors at Registered Farmers' Markets





¹**Processor License:** Processing/Manufacturing license for an approved facility that produces foods for sale and distribution; annual license.

²**USDA:** United State Department of Agriculture; usda.gov

³**ODAFF:** Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, & Forestry; oda.state.ok.us

⁴**TCS Foods:** Foods that must be maintained at 41°F to prevent the growth of harmful bacteria

⁵**Mobile Retail License:** Can sell prepackaged processed foods statewide; may also require an approved licensed commissary where the food is stored; annual license.

⁶**Non-TCS Foods:** Foods that do not allow for the growth of harmful bacteria due to processing or natural factors.

⁷**Seasonal License:** Can sell non-TCS prepackaged foods at one location; valid for 180 consecutive days.

Special Event Licenses are not available for regularly scheduled, reoccurring events, such as Farmers' Markets.

The aforementioned license exemptions are only applicable at Registered Farmers' Markets in Oklahoma.
