


Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) Licenses Required by Vendors at Registered Farmers' Markets





¹Processor License: Processing/Manufacturing license for an approved facility that produces foods for sale and distribution; annual license.

Special Event Licenses are not available for regularly scheduled, reoccurring events, such as Farmers' Markets.

The aforementioned license exemptions are only applicable at Registered Farmers' Markets in Oklahoma.

⁴TCS Foods: Foods that must be maintained at 41°F to prevent the growth of harmful bacteria

⁵Mobile Retail License: Can sell prepackaged processed foods statewide; may also require an approved licensed commissary where the food is stored; annual license.

⁶Non-TCS Foods: Foods that do not allow for the growth of harmful bacteria due to processing or natural factors.

⁷Seasonal License: Can sell non-TCS prepackaged foods at one location; valid for 180 consecutive days.
