September Is Sexual Health Awareness Month

Oklahoma City – County Health Department clinics and staff are dedicated to providing testing and education on reducing your risk for sexually transmitted infections.

OCCHD tests for gonorrhea, chlamydia, syphilis, HIV and trichomoniasis (females) and provides on-site treatment for some of these infections.

The Centers For Disease Control reports 15-24 year olds account for half of all new STD infections.

Regarding the Human Papillomavirus (HPV), they recommend that all boys and girls ages 11 or 12 years should get vaccinated. HPV can cause cervical and other cancers.
