

Education Requirements at the Oklahoma State Fair:

Oklahoma City-County Health Department (OCCHD) will conduct Food Safety/Sanitation training classes for State Fair food workers. Several Classes are offered to better accommodate the needs of the food vendors and to ensure that all food workers are properly trained.

Entry will be denied once the auditorium has reached the posted occupancy.

1. **TRAINING IS MANDATORY** for all food workers. This includes vendors that offer food samples.
2. In order to sign in for the class, you must show a state issued photo identification.
3. Food workers who hold a current managers certification from ServSafe, Prometric, Learn2Serve, State food safety or nation Registry of Food Safety Professionals, can be issued an OCCHD Fair Food Handler certificate by presenting the certificate along with photo identification at the registration table.

Training Class Protocol:

1. You may NOT sign in for anyone other than yourself.
2. Take care of all personal business before entering the training room. If you leave the room before or during the training, re-entry will not be allowed and a certificate will not be issued.
3. Turn off cell phones and electronic devices before entering the room.
4. No food or drinks will be allowed in the training room.
5. Seating is limited to individuals earning a certificate. NO CHILDREN will be allowed.
6. **If during the class you become disruptive, you will be asked to immediately leave the classroom and will not receive your certificate.**
